Hailed by The Times as “mesmerising: full of passion, imagination, and daring,” South Korean violinist SongHa (Bielefeld, 2000) is recognized as one of the leading musicians of her generation.

As laureate of the Queen Elisabeth Competition (2024), she has received major recent awards, including the Prix Reyl at the Verbier Festival (2024) and the Ana Chumachenco Award at the Kronberg Festival (2023).

As a soloist, she has collaborated with esteemed orchestras such as the Belgian National Orchestra, Montreal Symphony Orchestra, and Lithuanian National Symphony Orchestra. In addition, SongHa takes great joy in the collaboration with her sister Hayoung Choi (1st prize Koningin Elisabethwedstrijd cello 2022), in programmes for violin and cello.

SongHa’s education reflects her deep commitment to musical excellence. After completing her studies at the prestigious Yehudi Menuhin School in the UK under Professor Lutsia Ibragimova she continues her training at the Hochschule für Musik Hanns Eisler Berlin with Professor Kolja Blacher.

SongHa has performed at renowned venues including the Berliner Philharmonie, Wigmore Hall, and the Concertgebouw. A passionate chamber musician, she has appeared at leading festivals such as Verbier, Kronberg, and Gstaad.

Mozart Duo voor viool & cello K. 423
Various solo works for violin and cello (Cassado, Bartok, Prokofiev etc)

This program highlights the virtuosity of violin and cello through contrasting duo works: Mozart's elegant, lyrical writing (originally for violin and viola) and Kodály's rhythmically vibrant, folk-inspired style. The combination of these pieces, along with solo violin and cello works, creates a balanced and multi-dimensional experience for the audience. Performing this intimate repertoire with one's closest musical partner and sister adds a special personal connection to the music.

This programme is offered for both 60 mins and 90 mins programmes.

Hayoung Choi (Bielefeld, 1998) won first prize at the Queen Elisabeth Competition in 2022 and the Krzysztof Penderecki International Cello Competition in 2018. She studied at the Korean National University of Arts with Myung-Wha Chung and Hyongwon Chang, at the Purcell School for Young Musicians in England with Alexander Boyarsky, and continued her education at the Kronberg Academy with Frans Helmerson and Wolfgang Emanuel Schmidt. She has performed with orchestras such as Kremerata Baltica, the Frankfurt Opera & Museum Orchestra, and Camerata Salzburg, and has collaborated with musicians including Sir András Schiff, Gidon Kremer, Christian Tetzlaff, Kim Kashkashian, Jörg Widmann, and Mitsuko Uchida.
